

## UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES REQUEST

The FAFSA determines whether you must provide parent data based on the dependency questions. If you answer 'no' to all the questions, you are considered a dependent for financial aid purposes and must provide parent information on the FAFSA.	
If there are unusual circumstances where you cannot provide parent information, you may be eligible for a dependency override. A dependency override allows a student to receive financial aid eligibility without parent information.

<ul> <li>2. Provide one of the following:</li> <li>Three notarized statements, preferably from non-family members, indicating unusual circumstance, timeline of the relationship with parents and what type of contact you currently have with parents.</li> <li>Copy of legal documentation indicating incarceration or abandonment.</li> <li>Copy of legal documentation indicating refugee status, asylee status or victim of human trafficking.</li> <li>Other legal documentation supporting the unusual circumstance.</li> </ul>	
No action will be taken in cases where: -Parents refuse to contribute financially -Parents unwilling to provide information -Students being financially independent and/or parents not claiming student on tax return
