Stanly Community College is pleased to offer several need-based and merit-based scholarships. The amount for each scholarship varies, and the awards are used to help cover educational related costs.

Scholarships are awarded for one academic year. Students must reapply for a scholarship each year, with a possibility of renewal depending on Satisfactory Academic Progression.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will award scholarships based upon financial need, academic achievement and career interests.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

All students pursuing a degree or diploma at Stanly Community College are eligible to apply for a scholarship. To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must satisfy all SCC admissions requirements for their program of study, including all required placements tests.

In addition to this scholarship application, students must also submit the 2010-2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Students needing assistance are encouraged to contact the SCC Financial Aid Office. The scholarship application and the FAFSA must be submitted by April 15, 2010. Applications submitted after the deadline will be considered late and reviewed only as funds become available.

This is a two year scholarship program which includes a personal mentor for each scholar.

This is a two year scholarship program which includes leadership workshops.
