### Staff Council

**Staff Council Mission** – The Staff Council represents the interests and concerns of the Staff of the College. The Staff Council has the responsibility of formulating recommendations to present to the President for consideration in regard to policy matters affecting the College Staff.

**Membership** – Membership of the Staff Council is comprised of eight volunteer staff representatives for each of the following service areas:

- Student Success (2 representatives)
- Fiscal Services (2 representatives)
- Academic Affairs (2 representatives)
- President's Office (1 representative)
- Crutchfield Education Center (1 representative)

Areas with fewer than 16 people will have 1 representative and areas with 16 or more will have 2 representatives. Representation from the respective areas may change to reflect the number from their area. If the number of service area members drop below 16, the by-laws will be reassessed to reduce representation.

Staff Council members must be employed full-time and should have at least one year of service with the college before becoming eligible to be elected. Members of the Executive Leadership Team and Associate Vice Presidents are not eligible to serve. Staff Council members may not serve two consecutive terms.
