Departmental Credit by Exam Policy

Students enrolled in the Adult High School program may request a credit by exam to test out of up to two core classes in which the student believes they are proficient.

To qualify for a credit by exam, students must:

1. Have a minimum of four classes remaining to complete the Adult High School Diploma
2. Have a grade of "B" (80) or better in previous similar classes
3. Achieve a "B" (80) or higher to receive credit

Credit by exam can be requested for a maximum of two core classes. A credit by exam can be given only once per subject. The exam will consist of the final exam from the course in which the exam is being requested. If a student receives a "C" (79) or lower on the exam, then the student must complete that course in full to receive Adult High School credit.
