



SCC IS REQUIRED TO VERIFY YOUR PARENTS 2023 INCOME

Your 2025-2026 financial aid record indicates that your parents' 2023 income tax return information was not available or could not be used from the IRS.

Your parents are required to provide 2023 income tax return information.

The following are options for completing this requirement:

IRS Return Transcript – To obtain a 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript for your parent(s) go to www.irs.gov, click "Get Your Tax Record". Make sure to request the "Return Transcript". You can get the transcript mailed or print it from online. The Online option requires access to a valid email address, a text-enabled mobile phone in the users name and specific financial account numbers.

Also, there is an automated telephone request option by **c**alling 1-800-908-9946. *Transcripts are generally received within 10 business days from receipt of the request.*

- OR -

Signed Income Tax Return (2023 IRS-1040) AND Applicable Schedules for your parent(s). From the federal tax return form 1040 – only pages 1 and 2 are needed along with any applicable schedules following page 2 of the 1040 form. The tax return must be signed by the parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA.

Please indicate the student's name on transcript or tax return for accuracy.
