



SCC IS REQUIRED TO VERIFY SPOUSE 2023 INCOME

Your 2025-2026 financial aid record indicates that the 2023 income tax return information for your spouse was not available or could not be used from the IRS.

Your spouse is required to provide 2023 income tax return information.

The following are options for completing this requirement:

IRS Return Transcript – To obtain a 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript for your spouse, go to www.irs.gov, click "Get Your Tax Record". Make sure to request the "Return Transcript". You can get the transcript mailed to you or print it from online. The Online option requires access to a valid email address, a text-enabled mobile phone in the users name and specific financial account numbers.

Also, there is an automated telephone request option by **c**alling 1-800-908-9946. *Transcripts are generally received within 10 business days from receipt of the request.*

- OR -

Signed Income Tax Return (2023 IRS-1040) AND Applicable Schedules for your spouse. From the federal tax return form 1040 – only pages 1 and 2 are needed along with any applicable schedules following page 2 of the 1040 form. The tax return must be signed by the spouse.
