When you are ready to begin your journey please schedule an appointment for orientation. If you are seeking an Adult High School diploma, please provide an official high school transcript from the last public school you attended.

# Adult High School

The Adult High School Diploma program consists of classroom instruction, learning laboratory courses, distance education, or a combination of instructional methods of course objectives required to earn a diploma. This diploma is issued by the Stanly County Board of Education and Stanly Community College.

When you are ready to begin your journey, just schedule an appointment for orientation. If you are 16 or 17 years of age, you must have specific release forms completed and signed. These forms are available at SCC's website at [www.stanly.edu](http://www.stanly.edu). Please be prepared to provide an official high school transcript from the last public school you attended.

# Career Readiness Certificate

**Employers want it, do you have it? The National Career Readiness Certificate (CRC) proves to employers that you have the skills to do the job. A majority of the jobs in the U.S. require competency in applied mathematics, reading for information, and locating information.**

**Getting these skills is very simple. SCC provides individualized instruction in the classroom or online to help you build the skills necessary to take the CRC WorkKeys assessments.**

**Classes are multi-entry, allowing students to enter at any time during a scheduled class. Students can also utilize the CRC from home as an online class after they have come on campus to get registered. Fees are waived for qualified students!**



# English as a Second Language

English as a Second Language (ESL) is designed for those whose native language is not English. ESL classes help students improve their English through speaking, writing, reading, and conversation.

ESL classes can help you get a job, help your children with their homework, pass a citizenship test, and communicate in English in your everyday life.

Classes are offered on campus, off campus, and online. Convenient times are offered in the morning, afternoon or evening. Classes are FREE and books are provided for use in the classroom. You can complete the registration process when you attend your first class.

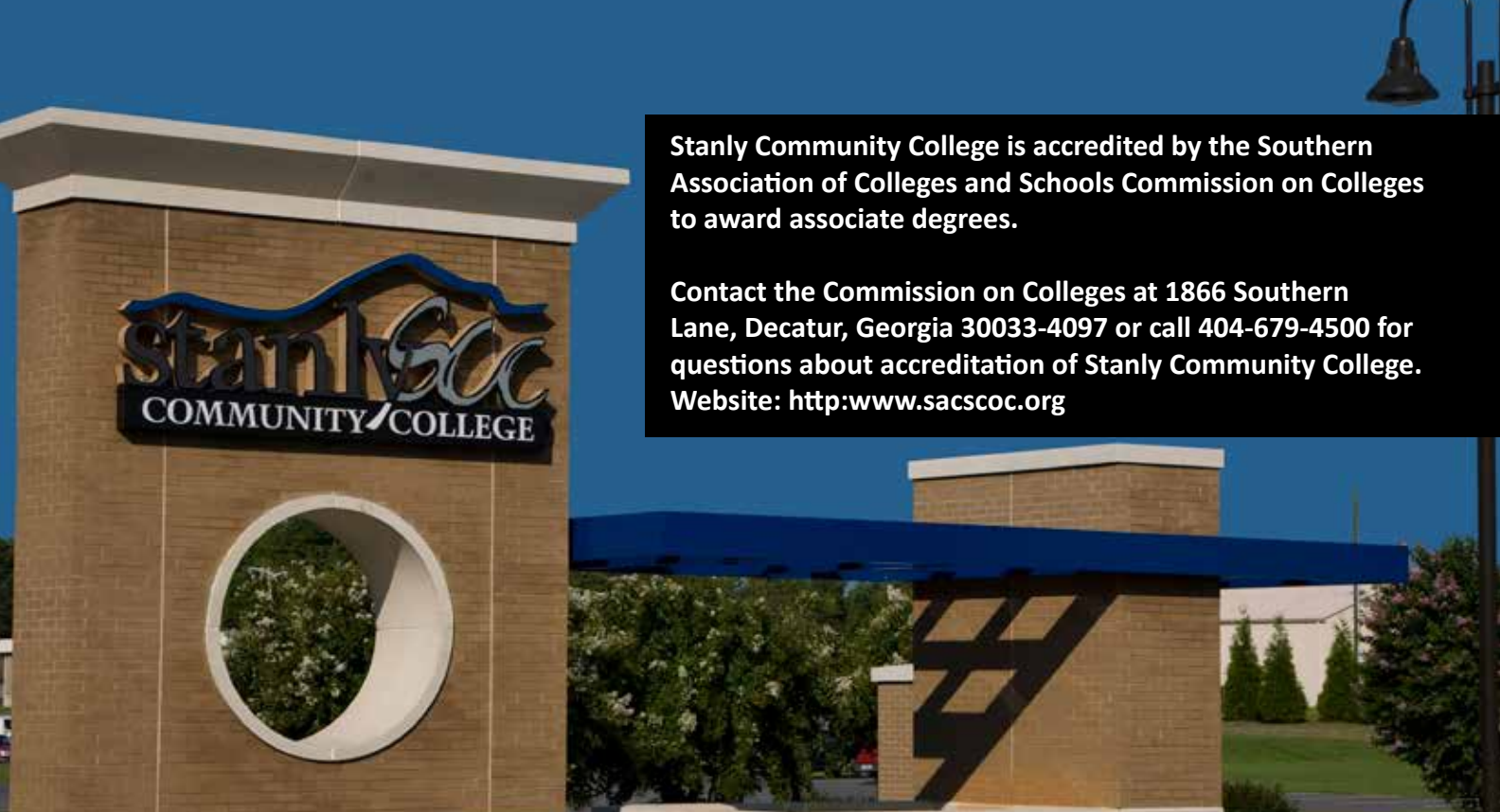


## Did You Know?
