NO REPORT OF CASE(S)	
<b>SCENARIO</b>	<p>*General pandemic conditions, no specific reports of on-campus exposure/cases</p> <p>*Potential exposure but not meeting threshold (6 feet, etc.)</p>
<b>ACTION NEEDED</b>	No Change
<b>CLEANING</b>	No Change from usual cleaning

YELLOW	
SUSPECTED CASE	
<b>SCENARIO</b>	Known exposure within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes without mask worn over nose and mouth
<b>ACTION NEEDED</b>	Notify on-campus/hybrid class or supervisor (no names for notification)
<b>CLEANING</b>	No Change from usual cleaning

<b>SCENARIO:</b>	<b>1 Case</b>	<p>*Give option to move class online (individual students can move online and ask instructor about support)</p> <p>*Notify SCC employees within threshold distance</p> <p>*Notify SCC partners within threshold distance</p> <p>*Recommendation only to consult medical provider for guidance on testing or restrictions (do not say "get tested" or give <u>any</u> medical advice)</p>	<p>Lab diagnosis of <b>5 or more cases in a single class</b>, linked per instructions of Stanly County Health Department</p> <p><i>(NOTE: the critical decision point is linkage according to SCHD. 5 different classes meeting at different times could each have a case that derives from community spread and not spread within SCC).</i></p>
<b>*Symptoms Reported</b>	<b>Additional case</b>	For each additional case, give class the option to move online (individual students can move online and get support from Center for Teaching and Learning).	
<b>OR</b>	<b>3rd Case</b>	3rd case within a single class within 14 calendar days -- no option, <b>MUST</b> move online for 14 calendar days from attendance of last confirmed case.	
<b>*Positive Test</b>			<p>*Close building for disinfection for 48 hours</p> <p>*Recommendation for all who were in the building during the time period (to be recommended by SCHD) to consult medical provider for guidance on testing or restrictions</p> <p>*Notify class or supervisor (no names for notification)</p>
<b>CLEANING</b>	<b>CLEANING</b>	Intensive cleaning where individual was present on campus (and document carefully)	<p>Follow CDC guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting your building or facility if someone is sick:  <a href="https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/disinfecting-building-facility.html">https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/disinfecting-building-facility.html</a>                      (Close space, wait to clean for 24 hours, and then deep clean.)</p>
